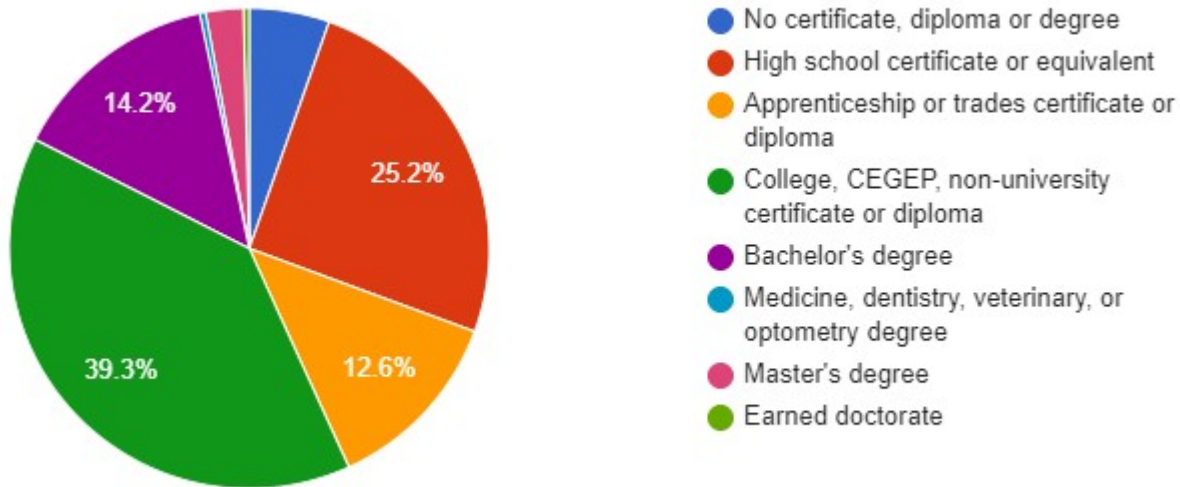

Educational Attainment



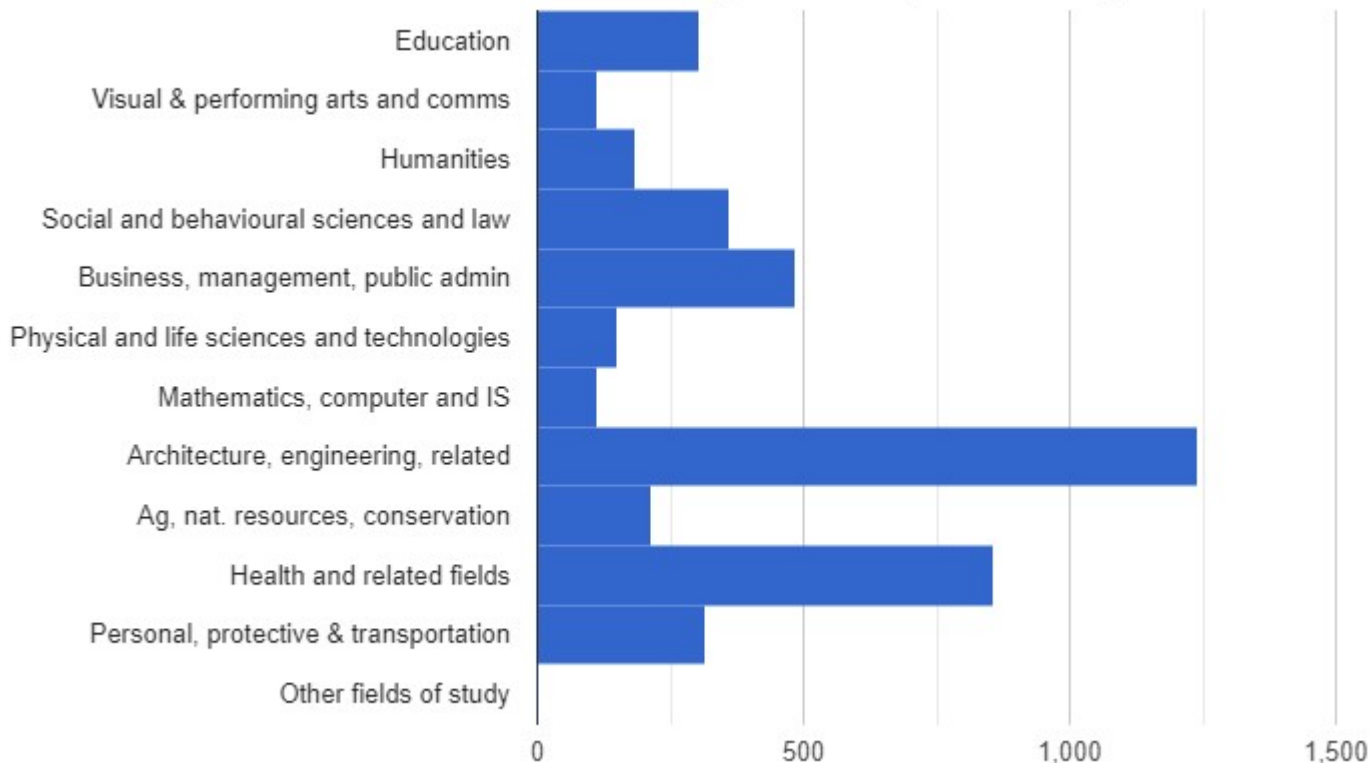
